 - c. How do you need and experience Jesus as he is the seed of Abraham who will bless the nations.
 - d. Which of these three aspects do you think it'd be helpful for you to grasp better as you ask Christ to help you live your life.
 4. Repenting leads to the blessing of times of refreshing. How often—or how recently—have you experienced and enjoyed this blessing that Christ won for you? Take a moment either to thank him for it or to ask him for more of it.
